

INSURANCE RULES FOR 2009-2010 ARENA SEASON

In October of 2004, the insurance company for all of California's fairgrounds, California Fairs Services Authority, began requiring insurance coverage for all day use riders at fairgrounds arenas.

Riders using the fairgrounds arena for day use need to provide proof of insurance along with the traditional waiver, and before being allowed to ride in the arena on a day use basis.

Acceptable insurance can be from one of three sources:

1. A homeowners policy that does not expire until sometime after the days of using the arena.
2. A Ranch/Farm policy with at least a one million dollar coverage amount, that does not expire until sometime after the days of using the arena.
3. An insurance policy purchased through the Lake County Fair office from California Fair Services Authority (CFSA). These policies are for individuals only (each family member will need their own policy). Each policy is good for 90 days from the date of original purchase, and costs \$40.

The CFSA policy is for individual use only, and not for training purposes, such as a trainer-student arrangement. Also, this policy covers only damage or injury to spectators and property. It **does not** provide coverage for the animal or rider.

Riders with homeowners insurance, or a Ranch/Farm insurance policy, are encouraged to provide a copy to the fair office as early as possible.

Horses Get Priority Again in 2009-2010

In keeping with the policies laid out by the Board of Directors of the 49th District Agricultural Association in 2001, equestrian events once again received priority in bookings of events in the Baldwin Pavilion arena for the 2009-2010 season.

Under the policy, equestrian events can be booked at anytime before October 1st. After October 1st, any dates which have not been booked with equestrian events are released for other activities, and often are booked for go-kart racing.

2010-2011 Equestrian events can be booked now!

Waivers:

All riders must sign a seasonal waiver for themselves and their minor children, in advance. The waiver must be updated each season, and must be on file in the fair office prior to any use of the arena.

All participants in any organized events in the Baldwin Pavilion arena must also have a separate waiver signed for the event.

Day Use Schedule

Rental Events take precedence over day use at all times. The Baldwin Pavilion is rented many Saturdays and some Sundays.

Week Days:

The Arena at the Baldwin Pavilion is available for day use during the weeks prior to equestrian events (see schedule) on Monday through Thursday from 9 am to 4 pm. **All horse trailers must stop at the Fair Office on the way in to the arena on week days!**

Sundays:

The Arena at the Baldwin Pavilion is available for day use on Sundays after equestrian events (see schedule) from 1 pm to 4 pm. Please note, some weeks the arena is booked on Sunday for events, and is not available for day use.

Fees:

The day use fee for the arena through March of 2010 is \$8 per rider, paid in advance. Riders are asked to keep their receipt with them because fair staff will ask to see rider's receipts.

Arena Night Use:

The arena is available for evening use as well, however arrangements must be made at least 24 hours in advance so that fair staff can be made available to operate the lights. The charge for the use of the lights is \$25 per hour, with no limit on the number of riders. However, each rider must pay the \$8 day use fee.

Arena Schedule:

Generally, the arena is available for use Sunday after a Saturday horse event, from 1 pm until 4 pm, when the Baldwin Livestock Pavilion is not rented for an event. It is also available Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 9 am until 4 pm. Riders must arrive before 4 pm and be done by 5 pm so that fair staff can lock up at 5 pm.

Be a good neighbor and clean up after your horse!
