

Step by Step Instructions for entering the 2011 Lake County Fair at www.lakecountyfair.com

In 2011, all Lake County Fair entries must be made on the internet. In order to enter the Fair contests, you will need access to a computer with internet access. Your home computer will work if you have internet access. Other places with computers available include libraries, schools, senior centers, and the fairground office.

The 2011 Lake County Fair Exhibitor Contest Handbook is available online at the Fair's website as well. Forms for livestock camping spaces and horse show waivers are available in the online Handbook.

Entering online is fast, convenient, and easy! Just open the web browser on the computer, and go to the fair's website at www.lakecountyfair.com. Use the computer mouse to follow the links and complete your entry!

1. Make sure you have read all the rules thoroughly (State and Local).
2. Start an entry with your personal information. Please use the exhibitor's name, mailing address and a daytime phone number. Junior exhibitors must complete additional information including birth date.
3. Select the proper division and class numbers for each entry. Make a separate entry for each item. A brief description of the item (example-quilt with yellow and blue squares, or a picture of two children with a dog, etc), or on livestock entries the correct information regarding size, color, sex, ear tags or notches, etc. is required.
4. Exhibitor and/or parent signatures are required. Print your entry receipt, sign it, and mail it with the proper payment to the Fair. Parents may sign for minors for still exhibits. Minors **and** parents must sign livestock and horse show entries.
5. U.C. Cooperative Extension representatives and FFA Advisors will be required to confirm the eligibility of all juniors entering from their 4-H club or FFA chapter, however, they will do so separately from this entry process and their signatures are not required to submit your entries.
6. Mail your entry receipts and fees to arrive prior to the deadline date.
Postmarks are not accepted!

7. You may drop off your entry receipts and fees at the fair office located at 401 Martin Street in Lakeport.
8. Deliver your items on the date specified in the boxes located in each department. Each department receives on a separate day. No late or early deliveries will be accepted.
9. For additional assistance or if you have other questions regarding your entries, look on the web at www.lakecountyfair.com, or call the fair office at (707) 263-6181. The fair office is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.
