DRUG REGULATIONS

HORSE DRUGGING REGULATIONS:

1. A fee of \$5.00 will be charged for every horse entered in the show as required by the State of California. Only the gymkhana horses are exempt.
2. **NO DRUG FEES WILL BE REFUNDED FOR ANY REASON.**
3. Any animal given any type of drug within 72 hours of the show date must fill out a written declaration form for each drug administered. These forms are at the horse show office.

REFUNDS

1. No refunds will be made without a vet or physician's certificate at owners expense.
2. Refunds of any kind, for any reason will be granted **ONLY** upon the approval of the Board of Directors of the 49th District Agricultural Association at their next regular meeting. Requests must be submitted in writing 12 days prior to that meeting. Refunds will be made if a Class is cancelled due to lack of entries.

STALL RATES

Box stalls will be \$15.00 per day.

REGULATIONS:

See State & Local rules.

1. This show will be run under the California State Horsemen's Assn. rules, both english and western, using West Coast Horse Show Rulebook unless otherwise stated.
2. Driving rules will be run according to the American Driving Society and/or the U.S.E.F. Gymkhana rules will be run according to the California State Horsemen's Association Inc. bylaws and rulebook.
3. The decision of the Judge is final.
4. No one under the age of 18 may handle or show a stallion on the fairgrounds.
5. **Adult's Code of Conduct** on page 76 must have a minimum of two (2) signatures which can be from either/or:
 - a. All parents or guardians of any child entering an animal in the Lake County Fair.
 - b. Each leader or advisor providing leadership to any child entering an animal in the Lake County Fair.
 - c. **This form must be completed prior to "check-in" at the fairgrounds for the competition.**
6. Junior Exhibitor age 17 and under must wear properly strapped headgear while mounted or in a horse-drawn vehicle on the grounds of the Lake County Fair. Headgear must be approved by American Society for Testing and Materials/Safety Equipment Institute.

7. For Open Horse Show purposes the age of an exhibitor on December 1 shall be maintained through the next calendar year for Junior Mount classes only.
8. Classes with an asterisk (*) require registration certificates to be shown. These may be:
 - a. Photocopies of registration certificates may be permitted for the purpose of submitting entries. However, the fair may request an original registration certificate and may disqualify the entry if it cannot be produced.
 - b. Lease Only: A copy of the registration papers and a copy of a notarized lease or purchase contract.
9. Management reserves the right to split or combine classes that are too large or too small. Any changes will be announced at least three (3) classes ahead of time.
10. Each owner is limited to two (2) premiums per class.
11. Please check with the show management as soon as you arrive on the Fairgrounds to get your number and passes.
12. Make sure you fill out your entry completely and include the entry fees. No stalls will be reserved without payment in full.
13. Novice classes are for horses that have not won three (3) Blue Ribbons.

4. **Adult's Code of Conduct** on page 76 must have a minimum of two (2) signatures which can be from either/or:
 - a. All parents or guardians of any child entering an animal in the Lake County Fair.
 - b. Each leader or advisor providing leadership to any child entering an animal in the Lake County Fair.
 - c. **This form must be completed prior to "check-in" at the fairgrounds for the competition.**
5. On entry form note the partners name for Class 4– Baton Race.
6. Jackpot Barrels, entries will be taken up to 3 classes ahead of time, no ribbons. Jackpot split: 1st place 40%, 2nd place 30%, 3rd place 20%, 4th place 10% of pot.
